October 31-November 10, 2022 11 Days

Hosted by Rev. Karoline Lewis, Ph.D.

The Women In Jesus' Life tour takes us to the Holy Land with a focus on the interactions between Jesus and women – the women without whom Jesus' ministry would hardly be successful. How might these women provide a unique perspective on the person and meaning of Jesus? How might we imagine our own discipleship in these women of faith, women who see in Jesus God's true character? Our pilgrimage to these holy places where Jesus walked and talked, where Jesus healed and performed miracles, where Jesus lived among us, will bring to life stories in Scripture that are our stories. In so many ways, we are these women, and they give us remarkable perspectives on our own discipleship and our own identity as followers of Christ.

Rev. Karoline M. Lewis, Ph.D., is the Marbury E. Anderson Chair in Biblical Preaching at Luther Seminary, St. Paul, MN, where she has taught since 2007. She is the author of *SHE: Five Keys to Unlock the Power of Women in Ministry* (including an accompanying facilitator guide, participant guide, and DVD) and *John: Fortress Biblical Preaching Commentaries*. Her next two books are *Embody: Five Steps to Leading With Integrity* and *A Lay Preacher's Guide: How to Craft a Faithful*

DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

MON 31 OCT Depart U.S.
Depart Chicago on the overnight transatlantic flight to Vienna and connect to Tel Aviv with Austrian Airlines (Meals in-flight)

TUE 01 NOV Arrive Tel Aviv/Dead Sea
Upon arrival, your guide and driver will be waiting to greet you. Transfer to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth. David Tower Dead Sea Resort & Spa (Meals in-flight)

WED 02 NOV Dead Sea
Awaken to a full day for relaxation and spiritual grounding - float in the briny waters of the Dead Sea if you wish. Gather for a welcome dinner this evening. David Tower Dead Sea Resort & Spa (B,D)

THU 03 NOV Dead Sea/Galilee
This morning ride the cable car up to the rocky plateau of Masada where the Zealots held their last resistance against the Roman conquerors. Travel through the West Bank to Nablus and a Greek Orthodox Church which houses Jacob's Well where Jesus met the woman of Samaria (John 4: 5-9). Continue to the Wedding Chapel at Cana. Later this afternoon arrive in Tiberias and check in at your hotel overlooking the Sea of Galilee. Royal Plaza Hotel (B,D).

FRI 04 NOV Galilee
Begin the day at Magdala, where contemporary efforts by the Catholic Church have unearthed a fishing village in Jesus' time - the birthplace of Mary Magdalene. As well as archaeological remains, there is a Women's Atrium devoted to the women of the Bible and women of faith across all time. Next is the Church of Beatitudes where Jesus delivered his Sermon on the Mount. Continue to Capernaum to see the remains of a first century synagogue where Jesus preached and the remains of what is most certainly Peter's house. In this contextual setting, explore the story of Jesus healing Peter's mother-in-law. End the day with a sunset sail across the Sea of Galilee. Royal Plaza Hotel (B,D) *Note: Communion kit will be provided on the board.*

SAT 05 NOV Galilee/Bethlehem
After hotel check-out, drive to Sepphoris, the village where Mary's parents Anne and Joachim were thought to have lived and where she was born. Next is Nazareth where Mary lived with her husband Joseph and raised their son Jesus. Visit the Church of the Annunciation and Mary's Well. Travel to Bethany on the eastern slopes of the Mount of Olives. The sisters Mary and Martha lived here and they hosted Jesus on several occasions. See the tomb of their brother Lazarus whom Jesus raised from the dead. Continue to Bethlehem for check-in, dinner and overnight. St. Gabriel Hotel (B,D)

SUN 06 NOV Bethlehem
This morning attend worship at Evangelical Christmas Lutheran Church (in Arabic) and enjoy fellowship with the congregation following the service. After lunch on own, take a walking tour of the Old City including the Church of the Nativity and Manger Square. The balance of the day is at leisure for study, reflection or exploration in Jesus' birthplace. St. Gabriel Hotel (B,D)

MON 07 NOV Bethlehem/Jerusalem
This morning meet with The Rev. Dr. Mitri Raheb and Palestinian women (Vera Baboun, former mayor of Bethlehem) who hold places of leadership in the community; discuss the role of women in Palestine. Depart for Jerusalem and the top of the Mount of Olives for a glorious view of the Golden City. Then walk down the Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane. Check in at your hotel just outside the Old City Walls. Golden Walls Hotel (B,D)

TUE 08 NOV Jerusalem
Spend the morning on a memorable guided tour of the Old City. Begin at St. Anne's Church which was built on what was believed to be the home site of Mary's parents, Anne and Joachim. Adjacent are the Pools of Bethesda where Jesus healed a man of his 38-year infirmity (John 5:1-9). Walk along the Via Dolorosa through the Old City to experience the Stations of the Cross; see the last few Stations located inside the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. See the ancient Western Wall, considered to be one of the holiest sites in the Jewish tradition. In the course of the day, meet with representatives of one or two Jewish women's activist groups. Golden Walls Hotel (B,D)

WED 09 NOV J Jerusalem
This morning spend time in the tranquil surroundings of the Garden Tomb followed by the balance of the day on own for individual exploration. Gather for a farewell dinner at an Armenian Restaurant. Golden Walls Hotel (B,D)

THU 10 NOV Return to U.S.
Transfer this morning for flight check-in and departure. Connect in Vienna with the continuing flight to Chicago. Arrive home today enriched with your discoveries of women in Jesus' life and women of the Holy Land today

TOUR CONDITIONS

PAYMENT SCHEDULE: Your reservation and deposit of \$500 per person are requested immediately to fulfill the group deadline requirements. Note that space is limited and reservations are taken on a first come, first served basis. A second payment of \$1000 is due June 30, 2022. Final payment is due no later than August 30, 2022. REFUND POLICY: All cancellations must be in writing. There is no refund for partial or unused land arrangements. Note: Airline tickets will be issued well in advance of departure and may be nonrefundable. The following penalties will apply: Up to June 29, 2022 - \$100 per person administrative fee plus any unrecoverable deposits; June 30 - October 10, 2022- Deposit plus any unrecoverable payments to hotels, tour operators or airlines; October 11, 2022 or after- No refund.
